



IAIM Training Costs & Fees, 2012

These fees and costs are correct at the time of publishing, but may be subject to change at short notice.

Training Fees for 2012 are: **\$995.⁰⁰**

This fee **includes:**

- Attendance at the four-day face-to-face training program, and practical assessment.
- All required text books.
- A comprehensive, fully-referenced compendium of course notes, as well as the official IAIM Instructor's manual and Teaching Protocols.
- 12-months phone/ email support from your Trainer to assist with your assessment tasks.
- Marking of your assessment papers.
- Issuance of your Certificate from IAIM, upon successful completion of all assessment tasks (*also see below)
- Student membership ID card, and update to Professional member ID card, on completing your assessment.
- 12-months student membership to IAIM Australia, inclusive of all benefits and access to all resources.

In addition, an early-bird gift is also provided to students whose course fees are paid in full, at least 6 weeks prior to the course commencement date. The early bird gift includes DVDs and extra resource materials valued at \$125. Group discounts are also available.

Substantial discounts apply for in-house training.

Essential extra costs (not included in your course fees) will include:

- A doll for demonstrating and teaching – these can usually purchased from Target or Kmart for around \$20-\$30.
- 5 x bottles of massage oil (compliant with the IAIM guidelines) to provide to parents attending your student prac course. You can source your own oils, or purchase them at the student rate from the IAIM shop.
- Incidental costs for example: postage of your completed exam to your trainer, photocopying of handouts for parents, tea & coffee for parents – etc.

Optional or variable extra costs (not included in your course fees) may include things like:

- Costs of airfares, travel, accommodation etc. to attend the face-to-face training.
- If you use an external venue to conduct your Student Prac Training, you will need to factor in hire fees, cost of petrol for travelling etc.
- Any additional resources you wish to purchase – e.g. books, materials to set up your teaching kit, etc.
- If you wish to have a photo added to your member ID card, there is an additional cost of \$10

Extra Fees Charged by IAIM are:

Nationally accredited statement of Attainment - **\$280**

All graduates automatically receive the Certificate in Certified Infant Massage Instruction, from IAIM which is recognised nationally and internationally. Graduates who **also** wish to be issued with the nationally accredited Statement of Attainment in Certified Infant Massage Instruction will be required to pay an additional fee of \$280. This is to cover the costs to IAIM of maintaining national accreditation. It is an "extra" fee as it is only passed on to those students who elect this option. You **do not** pay this fee up-front – but only if you request an accredited Statement of Attainment. You can do this at any time **after** you have completed your examination.

Refresher Course Fees - **\$300 + \$75**

Once you have completed your face-to-face training, you have 12 months to complete your examination. There are no late fees per se, but if you wish to submit your exam after the 12 months has passed, it is the policy of the International Training Committee that you re-sit the face-to-face training. In 2012, the cost of re-sitting the face-to-face training is \$300. You will also be required to renew your membership to IAIM Australia. In 2012, the cost of student membership is \$75.

IAIM Australia is a not-for-profit charity.

Course fees cover the costs of the Trainer, costs of materials and venues, travel, administration and ongoing support to students and members.
